The Position: We're looking for a Program Manager with experience in school-based health care and demonstrated proficiency in a non-profit leadership role. We offer the ability to establish your own professional work environment and the ability to travel occasionally.

The Program Manager position serves as the operational leader of the organization with the opportunity to help improve the health and wellness of youth throughout Washington. The position represents the organization at regional, state and national level. High level functions include: developing and maintaining organizational infrastructure, creating and implementing long term funding strategy, partnership development, leading advocacy and policy activities and providing technical assistance.

The Program Manager position is made possible through multi-year grant funding. The position is structured as a contract role in year 1 with the potential to move to an employed role in the future if decided on by the organization. Eligible applicants can include independent contractors or those who plan to become a contractor. An applicant would need to have a business license in place before a contract is executed. Consulting businesses are eligible to apply but preference is for one individual to serve as primary in the role.

A rate competitive similar to like positions in similar organizations is offered. The position is full time and will remain open until filled.
